

Board Member Duties

Directors must be CaRVTA members in good standing, hold a valid CA RVT license for 2 years prior to nomination, work in CA, and be willing to commit to a two-year term.

Directors are required to attend board meetings conducted by conference call. Board meetings are normally held every two months, and typically last about an hour. Directors are given the meeting agenda and supplemental documentation prior to the meeting and are encouraged to submit project proposals, ideas, and questions for discussion.

Directors are required to attend 1-2 face to face meetings each year at a time and location to be determined by the board.

To nominate yourself, or someone else, submit a letter of interest detailing why you want to serve on the board of directors, your contact information (including email, phone number, and address) and your CV or resume on or before October 31, 2017
