



## REGISTERED VETERINARY TECHNICIAN (RVT)

### Summary:

### Position Summary:

Reporting to the Veterinarian, the Registered Vet Tech (RVT) oversees the daily care of surgery patients, management, and administration of anesthetic/analgesic agents and other medications. The RVT is also responsible for the documentation of medical procedures and drugs and treatments given. The RVT will oversee client education and (in consult with the Veterinarian) flow of animals through Wallis Annenberg PetSpace Clinic upon intake and throughout stay until adoption.

- Graduated from accredited school of veterinary science technology (2 or 4 year program) required
- Current California Veterinary Technician License required
- 2-3 years working as Registered Veterinary Technician, animal shelter experience preferred
- Experience performing complex animal health technical procedures
- Experience establishing and administering general anesthesia for surgical procedures on animals as well as administering medications
