As a Surgery Technician you will be responsible for:

- Able to efficiently work in a fast paced environment mainly on (but not limited to) the surgical floor and in operating rooms
- Performing sterile scrub and assist doctors throughout surgical procedures including abdominal explores, cruciate repairs, fracture repairs, thoracotomies, and both laparoscopic and arthroscopic surgeries.
- Advocating for the patient, providing exceptional comfort, diagnostic, surgical, and nursing care to all patients
- Knowledge of the equipment and materials used and their availability and applications
